Christmas Fair

We'll be kicking off the festive season with the Christmas Fair, which is taking place on **Friday 22**nd **November**, 4pm to 7pm. As well as the magical carousel, there will be stalls selling crafts and Christmas goodies, face painters and refreshments. Refreshments this year will include hotdogs and jacket potatoes. Wristbands, for face painting and unlimited rides on the carousel can be purchased from the centre office at £1 each.

Christmas Lunch

Christmas Lunch will be served on **Monday 16**th **December** at 12pm. Come and enjoy a fabulous 3 course lunch, plus coffee and mince pies as well as entertainment.
